Dear XXXXXXX,

On behalf of the Eganville Curling Centre committee, we would be very pleased if XXXXXXX considered sponsoring us by way of a billboard on the wall of the ice area. Details are as follows:

Banner size would be 4 feet X 4 feet. You would provide a high quality image of the XXXXXXX logo and what you would like to appear on the board. We would do the rest. The professional sign will be created for us by SpeedPro signs in Pembroke.

Initial (first year) cost would be \$260 that includes the cost of the billboard (approx. cost of \$160). Subsequent annual sponsorship would be \$200.

The sponsorship year runs from Nov 1 to Oct 30 and you would be invoiced in Nov every year.

This year we will continue to offer weekend curling, curling lessons on Sundays in the fall, and youth curling lessons on Thursday afternoons. As you know, clubs like ours are key parts of the lifeblood of small towns like Eganville and counties like Renfrew, as is XXXXXXX. I should also add that your billboard will also be seen during the summer when the Rotary Club and the Farmers Market use the ice area for various public activities.

Also, if you become a billboard sponsor, we would like to offer XXXXXXX's employees (and partners/friends) a free game (up to 8 people) on any one of our Fun Weekend Curling nights - we have this at 7 pm on most Fridays OR Saturdays during the season and people normally pay \$10 each. Therefore, if XXXXXXX decided to organize a fun game some Friday OR Saturday night, the fees would be waived. We would also provide free use of club brooms, grippers and sliders, as well as basic skills and rules training for any "curling rookies". This could be used as a nice team building exercise for the staff, or just plain fun! And we have bar facilities, cable TV and board games in the centre too!
